[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy musical instrument, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy musical instrument, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is an end elevational view thereof, looking at the mouth piece end of the instrument; and
FIG. 7 is an opposite end elevational view thereof.

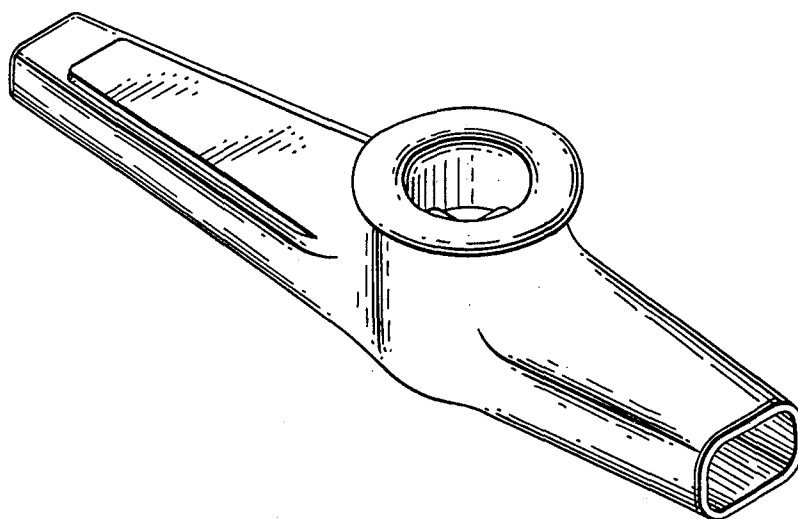

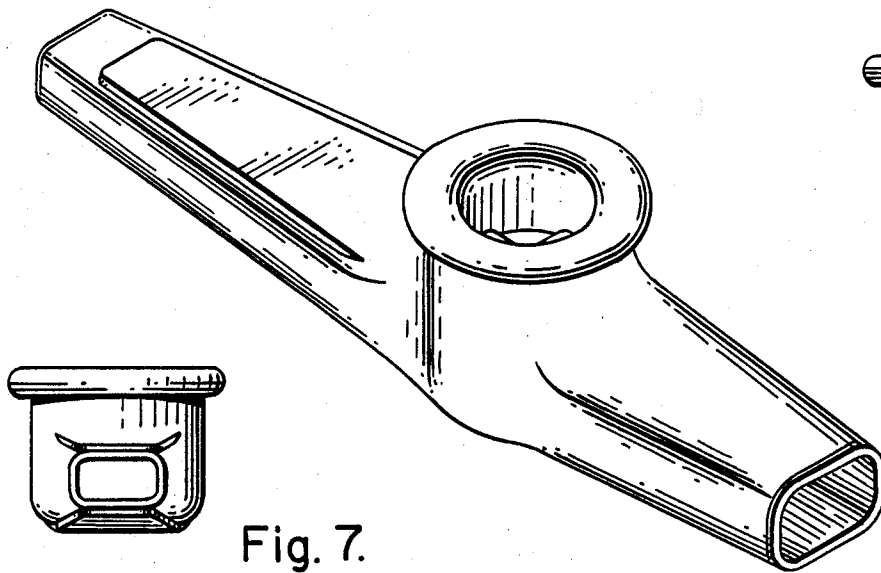

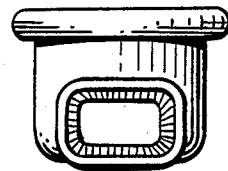

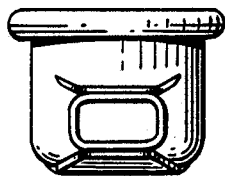

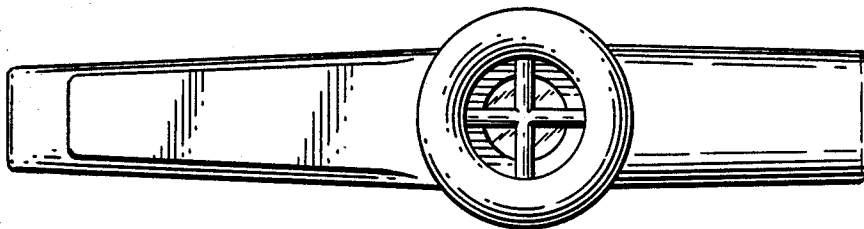

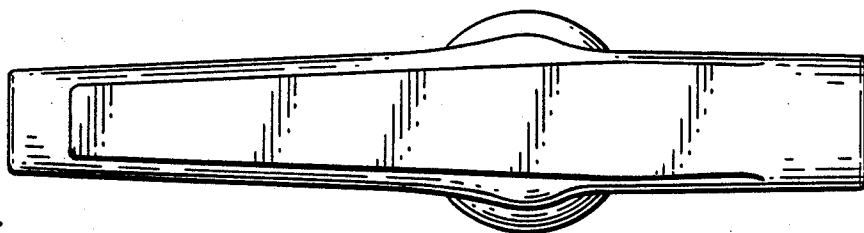

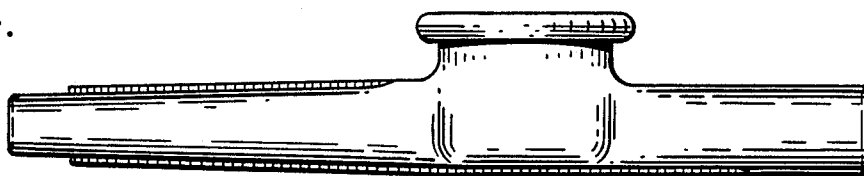
